An applicant must be a member in good standing with the Dayton Area Board of REALTORS® for at least 10 years. An applicant who has been found guilty of violating the Code of Ethics or the Ohio Revised Code during the past 10 years is ineligible.

Applications can be submitted by the nominee, DABR members or the Recognition Committee.

QUALIFICATIONS – An applicant is evaluated on the following participation criteria during all years of their membership with DABR:

- a. DABR Committees
 - Committee chairmanships
 - Committee memberships
 - Director Liaisons
- b. DABR Leadership
 - Director
 - Leadership Development Program
- c. DABR Event Participation
- d. DABR Education
 - Instructor of DABR classes; continuing education, pre-license, post-license, other
 - DABR sponsored classes
- e. Essay

The president of the Board, the president-elect, treasurer and the current members of the Recognition Committee shall not be eligible for nomination for the Distinguished Career Award.

The Distinguished Career Award may only be received once. Past recipients of this award are ineligible.
